

# SENIOR WILDLIFE TECHNICIAN (BISON)

## Terms of reference

### POSITION

The Senior Wildlife Technician (SWT) reports directly to the Wildlife Biologist but will cooperate with all personnel working on this project, both of FCC and of project partners.

### PRIMARY ROLE:

- Responsible for activities related to bison reintroduction;
- Ensures the security of the enclosure sites;
- Fulfils requirements for obtaining authorisation and permits;
- Participates in project update and planning meetings;

### SPECIFIC FOCUSES:

- Local responsible for a reintroduction site;
- Maintain communication with bison reintroduction external experts;
- Assists in obtaining building permits for enclosures and other authorisation;
- Assists in obtaining all the sanitary and veterinarian requirements;
- Assist in bison transportation;
- Responsible for the day-to-day care to bison until release;
- Keeps close communication and accompanies the designated veterinarian;
- Collects scientific data appointed by bison experts;
- Observes and reports bison behaviour;
- Applies monitoring procedures and registers data;
- Assists in information towards local authorities and people about bison;

### QUALIFICATION AND SKILLS:

- At least medium hunting or forestry studies are required; university degree is an advantage;
- At least two year of experience in wildlife management or care, large mammals preferably;
- Strong interest and good general knowledge about wildlife is required;
- Physical and mental fitness, suitable for carrying weapon permits;
- Flexibility regarding working hours and travel;
- Proficiency in use of Word, Excel, Internet, and eMail programmes;
- Driver's license;
