

JUNIOR WILDLIFE TECHNICIAN (BISON)

Terms of reference

POSITION

The Junior Wildlife Technician reports directly to the Wildlife Biologist but will cooperate with all personnel working on this project, both of FCC and of project partners.

PRIMARY ROLE:

- Assists in activities related to bison reintroduction;
- Guards and maintains enclosure site;
- Ensures care for bison;
- Carries out tasks and duties assigned by his supervisors;

SPECIFIC FOCUSES:

- Patrols the bison enclosure site daily;
- Assists in scientific data collection;
- Assists in bison monitoring activities;
- Provides supplement food and medicine to bison;
- Observes and reports bison behaviour;
- Carries out any other duties that may reasonably or exceptionally be required to ensure a smooth implementation of the ELP project activities;
- Assists in information towards local authorities and people about bison;

QUALIFICATION AND SKILLS:

- At least medium hunting or forestry studies are required;
- Strong interest and good general knowledge about wildlife is required;
- Physical and mental fitness;
- Suitable for carrying weapon permits;
- Willingness to work, travel and stay in remote locations;
- Must be able to use computers for editing documents and email;
- Driver's license;
