Terms of reference

POSITION

The Junior Game Warden (JGW) is responsible and reports directly to the Wildlife Biologist but will cooperate with all personnel working on this project.

PRIMARY ROLE:

- Ensures law enforcement and integrity of hunting concessions;
- Participates in the rapid intervention teams and resolves human-wildlife conflicts;
- Assists in field activities of the project;

SPECIFIC FOCUSES:

- Participates in rapid intervention teams in case of human – wildlife conflict;
- Patrols the designated area;
- Keeps a permanent contact to livestock owners in the area;
- Observe and reports to his/her supervisors;
- Collect samples, install camera traps and observes for wildlife monitoring purposes;
- Participates in other wildlife related activities of the project;
- Carries out any other duties that may reasonably or exceptionally be required to ensure a smooth implementation of the ELP project activities;

QUALIFICATION AND SKILLS:

- At least medium hunting or forestry studies are required;
- Strong interest and good general knowledge about wildlife is required;
- Physical and mental fitness;
- Suitable for carrying weapon permits;
- Willingness to work, travel and stay in remote locations;
- Basic computer skills for editing documents and email;
- Driver's license;
