

Forest conservation and management




December is always a quieter month than the rest. Apart from patrolling to prevent any illegal cutting of trees, we spend the time handling paperwork and planning for the next year's activities.

Looking back, in 2020 we bought 1,137 ha of forest:

- 426 ha are old clear-cuts in the Făgăraş Mountains and we will ensure they will be reforested again
- 711 ha are forests to be placed under conservation and alpine meadows to be restored and implemented with a balanced grazing management









Ecological restoration

- We rest... The seeds are either deposited in the seed banks or already planted. The saplings up in the mountain are covered with a good blanket of snow. Sweet, quiet hibernation, after an intense year of activity in our tree nurseries and green houses...
- <u>2020</u> meant tough conditions for the seasonal workers, volunteers and rangers and, despite the pandemic, we managed to plant 375,000 saplings on 87 ha of old clear-cuts. A new forest is brought back to life, with the donations of many organisations and people.

Wildlife monitoring

• The first <u>bison calf</u> born in the wild in Făgăraș is doing well.

- More bison have completed the initial group in Dâmboviţa Valley: five additional bison have been brought to the enclosure in Bunea. Our team worked hard to properly accommodate them.
- We finished the new quarantine and acclimatisation enclosure in Lereşti, the second release site, and brought the first bison to the area. More will follow throughout the winter for release in spring.
- In Nucşoara, we started plans for the third release enclosure, which we will build throughout the winter.
- For us, 2020 is the YEAR OF THE BISON!

Wildlife monitoring

- The rangers are busy checking the lynx camera traps installed to monitor this species during the winter season.
- At the same time, our lab biologist is busy preparing the DNA samples for the red deer study.



Wildlife management:

- In certain hotspots we install monitoring cameras to check on poachers or other illegal activities. However, the only "poacher" we caught on camera is a four legged one – a solitary wolf.
- Our rapid intervention teams have provided consultation about bear attacks and problems even beyond our project area.








Wildlife management:

- A year ago we had tremendous problems with bears and boars in parts of our wildlife management concessions, but this year everything is much quieter. Without doubt this is partially due to the rich beech mast this year, but it also shows the success of the intensive work of our wildlife intervention teams.
- We continue patrolling every day to prevent wildlife from getting too close to the villages, with positive results.







Conservation Enterprise Programme

COBOR biodiversity farm

- The horses got their periodical "spa" treatment.
- We received funding for a mobile abattoir, which will help us to produce high quality organic meat without having to drive the cattle to slaughterhouses, where conditions are often appalling.
- At the farm, we are happy no-one had to be laid off in this difficult year and we hope for better times for travelling and more guests in 2021!
